

Blankiet Estate Port Prince of Hearts # 7

“Beautiful dense and brilliant color. The glycerin legs dripping down the glass already show the richness of this wine. Delicate nose of cedar and white pepper. The tannins are present and bring energy and definition. Rich and succulent without heaviness. Notes of black fruit like dark wild raspberries, bringing depth and a restrained austerity that is delightful. The mouth is dominated by fruit but framed by sweet tannins, giving complexity to the wine. The balance is remarkable and the tannins perfectly integrated. A long finish supported by supple and fine tannins. Crushed black berries and subtle notes of white pepper at the end gives a great complexity to the wine. Huge aging potential.” **19.5 out of 20**
